Historical background of the Austrotel Hotel Salzburg

In 1653 the building was built by Archbishop Paris Lodron as a residence for himself, his family and his successors.

Much of the palace was destroyed in the fire of 1818. An inn called “Zum roten Krebsen” was erected in its place and became a popular meeting place for Salzburg society.

Later the house was lovingly and skilfully restored and opened on 1 August 1987 as Austrotel. Ten years ago it was purchased privately. Thanks to its individual style and central location, it is now one of the most popular and renowned Salzburg hotels.
